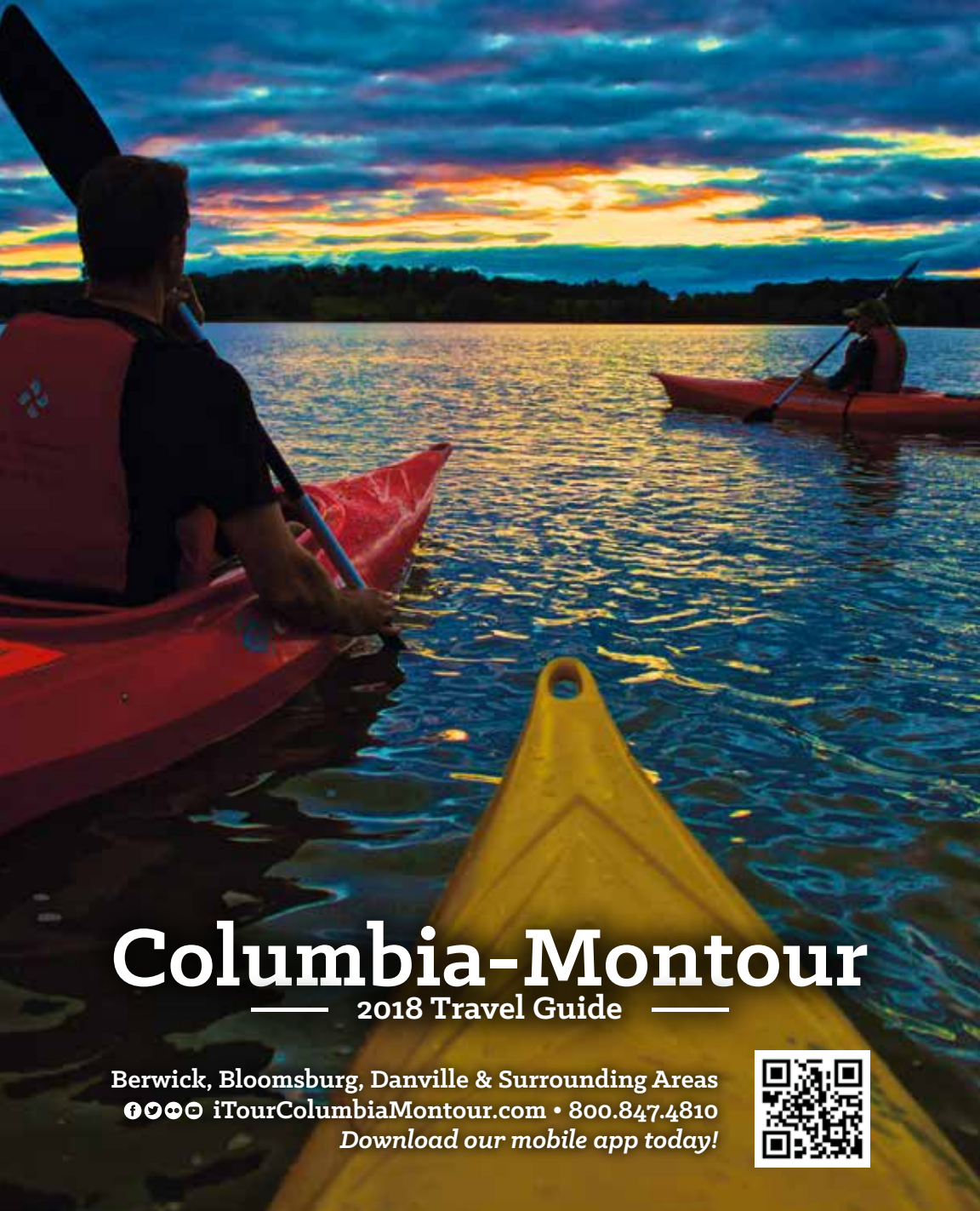

Location

Conveniently located near Interstate 80 and State Routes 11, 487, and 42, the Columbia-Montour County region is easily accessible from any direction and has a welcome center located in Bloomsburg.

Route 11

In Bloomsburg

- Follow Route 11 until it intersects with Route 487
- Follow Route 487 North approximately 2 miles
- Turn left onto Papermill Road

Route 487

The Columbia-Montour Welcome Center is located at the intersection of Route 487 and Papermill Road, as it intersects I-80 at exit 236.

- When traveling Route 487 South, take a right at Papermill Road (at the Sunoco Gas Station)
- Follow the Visitor Center signs

Our Columbia-Montour Welcome Center is located at exit 236 (Bloomsburg/Lightstreet) off I-80.

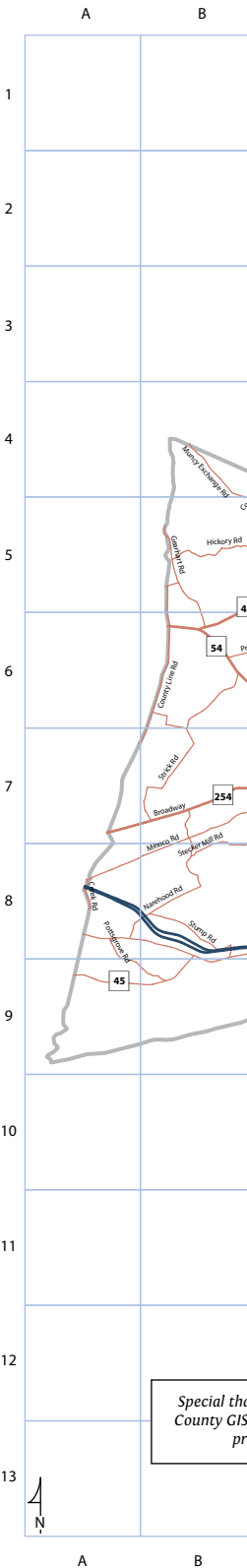

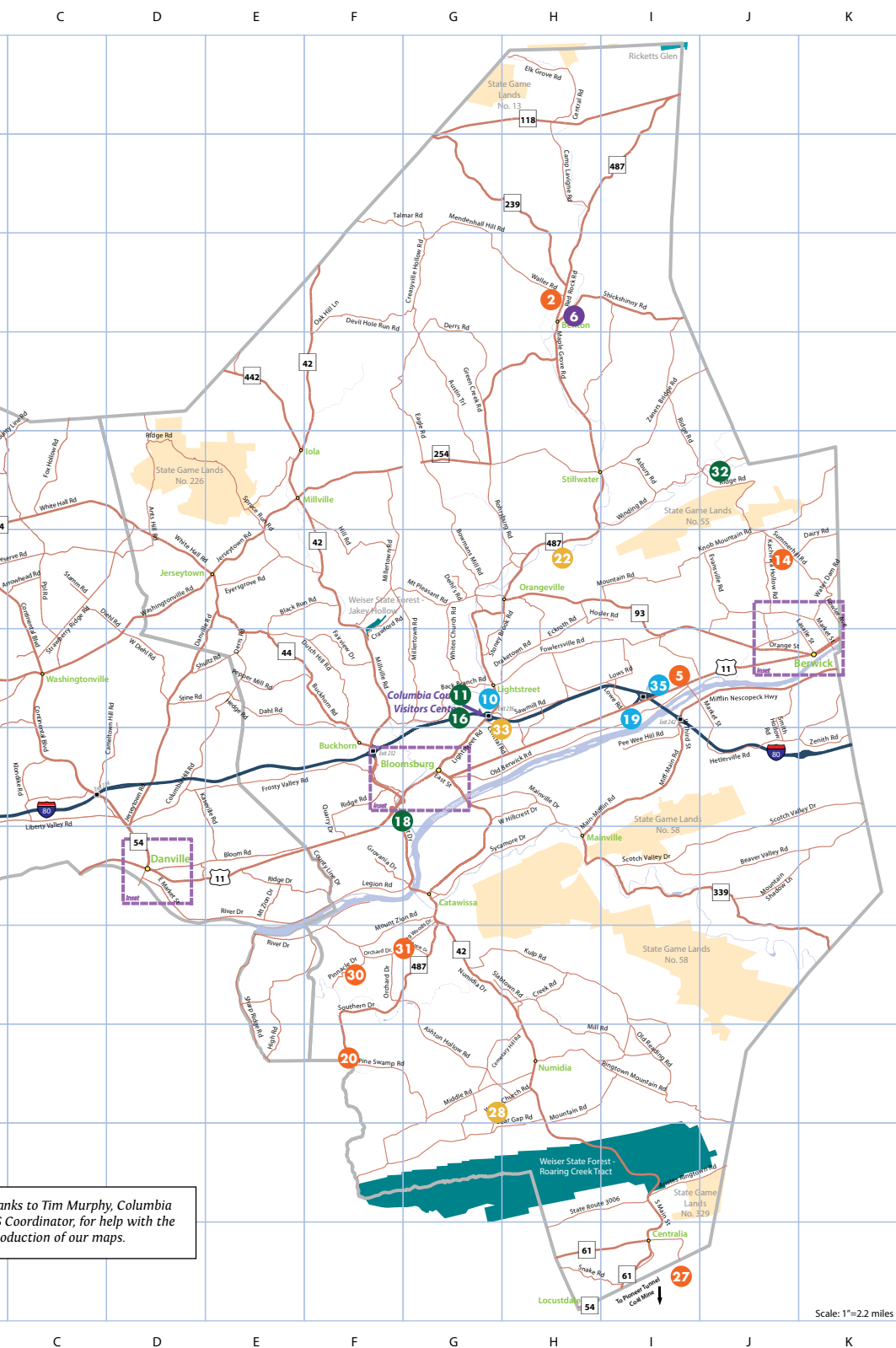

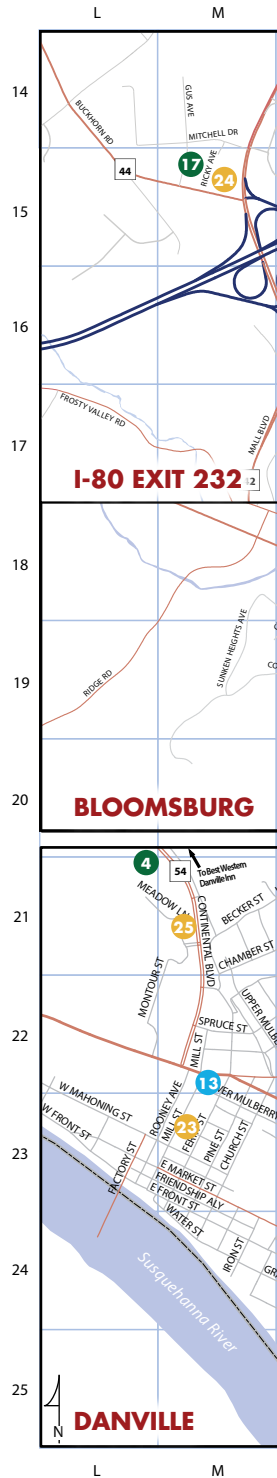

AREA HIGHLIGHT

Arts & Entertainment

Columbia and Montour counties possess museums, theatrical events, galleries, arts and crafts festivals, artist co-ops, and much more. One can stroll through Bloomsburg University's Haas Art Gallery or the Gallery at the Greenly Center to view seasonal exhibits by both students and local artists. The Exchange Gallery and Artspace Gallery in downtown Bloomsburg each offer monthly exhibitions and showcase local talent at its finest. Bloomsburg Theatre Ensemble, Bloomsburg University's Celebrity Artist Series, and Bucknell's Weis Center for the Performing Arts are three venues to explore if performances are part of your quest for culture. If you're pursuing family histories and genealogies, perhaps you will look to visit one of our area Historical Societies.



An Amusement Resort that Offers Fun for Everyone!

H.H. Knoebel Sons Lumber Company was established around 1922. At that time, there was no way of knowing that the family business would evolve to include America's largest free-admission amusement park and many other recreational activities. Fast-forward to 2018 - guests of all ages, from near and far, visit Elysburg to experience thrilling rides, award-winning food, swimming, camping, shopping, games and golf.

The "amusement" aspect of Knoebels Amusement Resort officially began with a swimming hole. In 1926, the Crystal Pool, a carousel, and a food stand were added. Over the next several decades, the amusements continued to grow at what some might consider a gradual pace.

"When I returned home from the Marines in 1965, the park had 16 rides and nine food stands," said Dick Knoebel, president and co-manager of Knoebels. "Now, we offer more than 60 rides and attractions, 30 food and beverage locations, 28 midway games, 17 gift shops and more."

The park experience might seem too good to be true, but it's not. Amusement park rides aren't your thing? You can visit Knoebels with your family and enjoy the day without paying to enter the park. You also have the option of paying for only the rides you choose to ride. In addition to free admission, Knoebels is also known for its free parking and free picnic facilities. Speaking of free, daily entertainment is also offered and includes live music, magic shows, costume storytelling, puppet shows, and more – all at no charge.

Chances are there will be plenty for each and every family member to enjoy, whether he or she is a thrill seeker, a nostalgia seeker, or someone seeking some of the best food offered at an amusement park, or all of the above!

Knoebels is a regular finalist in a number of categories for the amusement industry's Golden Ticket Awards, presented by Amusement Today. For some, the food is the best ride in the park. Knoebels has received the distinction of "Best Food" 15 of the past 18 years. Its 105-year-old Grand Carousel has won the



award for “Best Carousel” every year the award has been presented, and its classic Phoenix roller coaster consistently ranks in the top five wooden roller coasters in the world, most recently ranking as second best.

Amusement park offerings aren’t the only areas where the fun has grown throughout the years. What could be more delightful than camping at an amusement park? Knoebels Park Campground, which is attached to the amusement park, opened in 1963 with nine campsites. Today, there are over 600 sites, plus the addition of a sister campground that joined the family in 1997. Lake Glory Campground is located just a few miles from Knoebels, and offers nearly 200 campsites in a picturesque setting. If you don’t have a tent or camper of your own, check out Knoebels’ rustic cabins, efficiency units and cottages.

Have a golfer in the family? In 2007, Knoebels continued its transformation into an even more complete family resort with the addition of an 18-hole, regulation golf course. Three Ponds Golf Course had been owned and operated by the Jepko family since it first opened with nine holes in 1959. It was expanded to 18 holes in the ensuing years and subsequently renamed “Knoebels Three Ponds.” The addition of the course made sense because of its close proximity and potential for integration into guests’ visits.

The course is semi-private; it serves its loyal members and also welcomes visitors to the area during their vacation at the park. New opportunities that foster the next generation’s love of the game have been added to the golf course’s activities, such as Family Nine and Dine nights and

Youth Clinics, as well as events such as Women’s Golf Clinics, and tournaments.

On the site of Three Ponds Golf Course, the new Nickle Plate Bar & Grill offers a year-round Knoebels dining experience. In addition to a regular menu, patrons can enjoy weekly food and drink specials, and trivia or live music on select days.

“While we continue to expand our offerings, we always want to be a place for all ages to enjoy, whether you are visiting us for one hour, or one week,” said Knoebel. “We are a family business that hopes to continue to create family fun and memories for multiple generations of visitors.”

Every Taste Tells a Story

As the winter frost gives way to spring growth, a new season unfolds at each winery in Columbia & Montour Counties. Every location takes pride in creating unique and flavorful products, and each finished bottle is a physical representation of the hard work and dedication placed into their craft. While the Finger Lakes may immediately come to mind to the casual wine enthusiast as being the place to visit for a weekend of wine and fun, Central Pennsylvania boasts plenty of enterprising wineries and gorgeous countryside of its own. In fact, one would be hard-pressed to find such a perfect balance elsewhere – the counties' quaint towns and peaceful country roads are the ideal setting for a weekend of wine tasting.

In Montour County, the charming river town of Danville plays host to two wineries: Red Shale Ridge Vineyards and Shade Mountain Winery & Vineyard. Both are outlet locations; the home wineries are located in Hegins, PA and Middleburg, PA, respectively. Downtown Danville also provides some great shopping and antiquing opportunities, not to mention several quality restaurants – making the town a perfect hub to begin your wine adventure.

Red Shale Ridge is family owned and operated. Owner Tom Stutzman began as a home winemaker in 1979. The family planted their first grapes in 1997 and began producing wine for friends and family. Ten years later, the winery opened using locally grown fruits and grapes from Pennsylvania. Today, the family still works very hard to provide quality wines to customers. The winery also has a location in Palmyra and local stands at the Mt. Carmel and Schuylkill Haven Farmers Markets.

Shade Mountain is also a family-owned and operated vineyard and winery that utilizes homegrown grapes to craft each and every bottle. Their vineyard in Middleburg encompasses 70 acres and includes over 30 different varieties of grapes. Their expansive decks attached to their 19th Century bank barn provide fantastic panoramic views of the vineyard and Central PA valley. Shade Mountain's Danville/Riverside location is nestled between the river and train tracks and has both indoor and outdoor seating. They offer daily tastings of over 50 different varieties of red, white, blush, fruit and seasonal wines.

Heading east into Columbia County will bring travelers to seven more wineries. **Pickering Winery's** second location opened in October of 2013 and is located just a mile north of Lightstreet. Susan and Lanny Sheehan manage that store, pairing wine with welcoming hospitality and the nostalgic atmosphere of a 200-year-old grist mill in the Shops at Forever Green Complex along Fishing Creek. A unique specialty at Pickering Winery is the custom decoration of bottles and glasses, along with many other items, which are laser engraved on site.

Nearby, **Three Dogs Vino** opened its "wine kennel" in November 2015 after a hobby turned passion for master vintner/owner Greg Bower. The winery features handcrafted, signature wines with playful dog themes inspired by Greg and his wife Shelli's three dogs. Unwind in a peaceful natural setting while enjoying a glass of "Three Bitches in Heat", "Cone of Shame", or "Lazy Daze", to name a few. The winery also features a unique "wine on tap" system to serve at weddings or special gatherings. Three Dogs Vino is located just outside of Bloomsburg, and only minutes from Interstate 80 and Route 11.

Situated in the heart of the northern Columbia County countryside, **Purple Cow Winery** was established in 2014 by the Hemsarh family when they turned their love of winemaking into a livelihood. Purple Cow Winery's vineyards consist of over 10 varieties in two locations. Their tasting room is energetic, lively, and fun, with an assortment of games to enjoy with family and friends. Experience some of the locals' favorites: Crazy Heifer, Hooves to the Moon, and Comfortably Numb. Purple Cow Winery is only open seasonally, however, so stop in before their doors close for the winter.

Elk Mountain Winery and **Colonel Ricketts Hard Cider** can both be found further north in the town of Benton. Elk Mountain Winery's outlet store is located inside Stoney Acres Garden Center just north of town on Route 487. They offer a tasting room with over 30 wines available daily for tasting, from the driest Chardonnay to their many sweet and fruit wines. Throughout the year, Elk Mountain offers various "plant and sip" classes that reflect their wine and garden center setting. Enjoy the gift shop, garden center, and tree nursery for a very unique wine experience.

Colonel Ricketts Hard Cider Winery started as a hobby more than 40 years ago and developed into the family business. Locally-grown apples are pressed for each and every bottle. Their products are then aged in oak whiskey barrels, giving the cider its signature flavor. During the summer and fall, their tasting room is located in the historic Green Acres Barn. Cold weather sends them to their Cider Shack for winter and spring tastings. Large groups or visitors requesting a tour of their barrel room are asked to call ahead.

Freas Farm Winery and **O'Donnell Winery** can both be found in eastern Columbia County. Freas Farm Winery was recently named the 2017 Columbia-Montour Small Business of the Year. They offer a variety of award-winning farm-to-table wines, including many dry, sweet, red, and white PA-Preferred products. Their specialty collection includes a port and fruit wines made with 100% all-natural fruit juice. Guests can relax and sip wine on their patio, porches, or under their shady trees. Make s'mores with port at their fire pits and enjoy a full slate seasonal entertainment.

After learning his trade in the Columbia Valley of Washington State, Norbert O'Donnell traveled back home to create fine wines for family and friends and eventually settled at the historic colonial home at 25 Hayes Road. O'Donnell Winery now offers customers a scenic park setting with both indoor and outdoor seating, along with a bit of local history and mystery.

Those looking to spend time savoring sips at these nine area wineries can request a copy of the Visitors Bureau's free "Wineries of Columbia & Montour Counties" brochure. Individual winery hours and more detailed information can be found at each winery's website or Facebook page. Regardless of whether you visit the wineries with a group of old friends, co-workers, family, or your significant other, new memories are waiting to be uncorked!

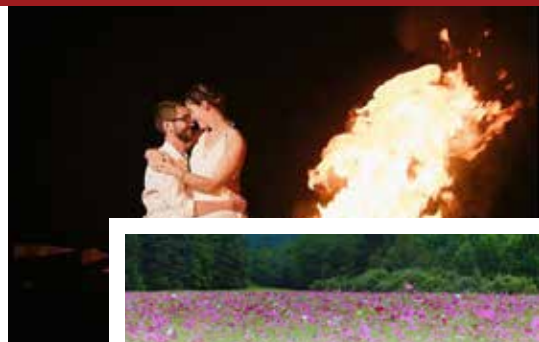

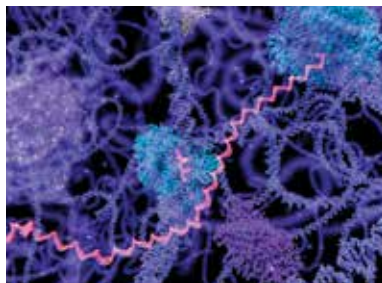

AREA HIGHLIGHT

Outdoor Recreation

One of the major highlights in the area, Ricketts Glen State Park contains 22 breathtaking waterfalls and a scenic 7.2 mile Falls Trail Loop, as well as a beach and lake. In southern Columbia County, the highlight of Weiser State Forest – Roaring Creek Tract is the eight-mile hiking/ biking trail that takes visitors past three scenic reservoirs. For water activities, the mighty Susquehanna River meanders directly through the counties. The river provides plenty of aquatic recreation opportunities including kayaking, fishing, canoeing, and tubing. Many local parks offer more great hiking and biking trails. 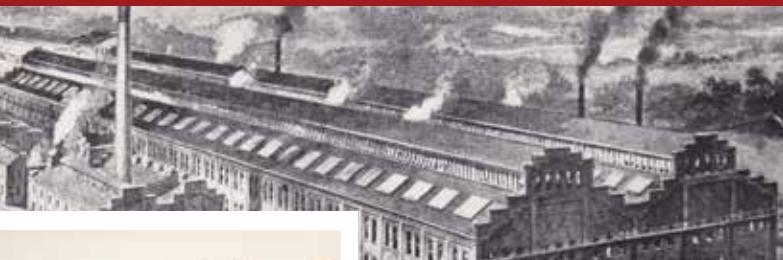

BERWICK

Then & Now

In the late 1700s, Berwick was actually called Owensburg after its founder Evan Owen, a Welsh Quaker. Owen came to this region from Philadelphia in 1772 and settled in the area along the Susquehanna River. By 1780, Owen and another family had built small adobes to live in until more permanent structures could be built. Owensburg was officially established in 1786. The next settlers were the John and Robert Brown families, who built log houses in 1795. It was Mrs. Robert Brown who, having been born in Berwick-Up-on-Tweed, England, persuaded Evan Owen to change the name of the town to Berwick.

In 1828, ground was broken for the North Branch Canal along the Susquehanna River, and Berwick became one of the major stops along the route. The first telegraph line went through Berwick in 1850 and with the Lackawanna and Bloomsburg Railroad reaching Berwick in 1858, the community was destined to be a center of commerce.

By the late 1800s, the major industry in town was the Jackson & Woodin Manufacturing Company, which most notably produced

railroad cars. The company started as a simple foundry and blacksmith shop in the 1840s but quickly expanded to begin producing mine cars by the 1860s. In 1899, Jackson & Woodin was one of 13 railroad car manufacturers that were merged to create the American Car & Foundry Company (ACF). By the time of the merger, Jackson & Woodin had grown to be the largest freight train and subway car manufacturer in the eastern United States, with total assets in excess of \$60 million. In 1904, the plant produced the world's first all-steel passenger car, which was part of an order by the New York City Subway system.

William Hartman Woodin, who would later make a name for himself as the Secretary of the Treasury under Franklin D. Roosevelt, became president of the firm in 1916. In 1933, Woodin was largely responsible for bringing the country out of the economic crisis of the Great Depression by advising President Roosevelt on his "Bank Holiday" policy.

In later years, the American Car & Foundry Company would churn out over 15,000 Stuart

Tanks for the World War II effort. During the war, the ACF was the largest national producer of armor plating, and Berwick was the #1 tank-producing community in the country. At peak production, the plant was producing 40 Stuart Light Tanks per day, with a total of 9,135 workers employed throughout northeastern Pennsylvania. During this time, the plant also continued producing millions of artillery shells and hundreds of railroad cars.

In 2016, the Borough of Berwick's Stuart Tank Committee was able to raise sufficient funds to bring home an authentic Berwick-built Stuart tank. The "Stuie" tank was built at the Berwick ACF in December of 1942, and has now been enacted as a moving memorial to ACF workers who produced the tanks. Visitors may find it at the annual World War II Day in Berwick or at the Bloomsburg Fair.

Snack food production has been another giant industry in Berwick. The Wise Potato Chip Company was founded in Berwick in 1921 by Earl Wise. He owned Wise Delicatessen and began making potato chips in his mother's kitchen as a way of using excess potatoes. Mr. Wise then sold the chips to deli customers in a brown paper bag. Mr. Wise continued producing the chips, and soon the delicatessen owner became a potato chip mogul. Wise had his first delivery truck by 1922 and opened his first production plant in 1925. After World War II, additional snacks such as corn chips, Cheez Doodles, pretzels, popcorn, and peanut butter sandwich crackers were added to the business.

Berwick is also famous for one of the nation's largest ribbon manufacturers: Berwick Offray. Originally known as Berwick Industries, their roots began in 1945 with a focus on manufacturing a non-woven ribbon product known as "Satinette". They later developed an all plastic ribbon called "Splendorette" which is still made in Berwick and widely used for Christmas & decorative packaging.

Today, Berwick is still a thriving community that takes pride in its history and culture. Preserving that history has long been a key focus of community members and local non-profits. One example of these efforts - the Ber-Vaughn pool - was a town hotspot from the 1970s-90s but fell upon hard times and closed in 2011. In 2012, extensive town fundraising, led by

the Berwick Area United Way, made it possible to renovate the location into a new state-of-the-art public pool. Similarly, the Berwick Theater began struggling to compete with the new multiplex movie complexes. In 2014, a non-profit organization, the Berwick Theatre and Center for Community Arts, was formed with hopes of revitalizing the old theater and bringing the classic movie experience back to Berwick. After renovations to the theater, it re-opened on August 12, 2016 to a sold-out crowd. Admission tickets still only cost \$5 and popcorn is \$1.50.

For more than 50 years, Berwick residents have had the luxury of purchasing fresh produce directly from local farmers at the Berwick Farmers Market. This market is located at Crispin Field, but a second location was recently opened in the downtown area - Beyond the Blend Market. Beyond the Blend is supported by the United Way as a means of further growing awareness and connecting low-income families to the Farmers Market. The market offers evening hours and additional vendors to make shopping more convenient for a wider range of customers. Beyond the Blend is open year-round and offers grass-fed meat, cheese, eggs, spices, honey, and much more.

Today, Winterfest and Celebrate Historic Berwick are two must-attend events in the town. Winterfest takes place the first weekend in December, and serves as a grand celebration to kick off the holiday season. The main attraction is annual Berwick Christmas Boulevard - a mile of lights along Market Street. This is one of the oldest Christmas light displays in the state. After walking the Boulevard, attendees can enjoy the many free downtown activities provided by businesses and local organizations. Celebrate Historic Berwick has evolved over the past few years to its newest location on Market Street near the historic Jackson Mansion. The event not only showcases the vibrant history of the town, but also the businesses of the community today.

From a rich history in industry to today's farmers markets, small-town entertainment, and heritage events, Berwick has plenty to offer!

Antiquing

There is something to be said for taking an afternoon or weekend to slow down and remember the way things used to be. By stepping inside one of the area's many antique shops, you'll discover the things that our ancestors loved and used in their everyday lives. Visitors to one of the area's eight shops will find nostalgic memories of days gone by, along with vintage furniture, primitives, pottery, linens, jewelry, books, records, toys, and much more.

A DAY ON THE TRAILS AT HOPEWELL PARK

As I unpack my bicycle, click on my helmet and do my pre-ride routine, I'm wondering what is in store for me for the next few hours. The parking lot and trailhead of Hopewell Park is pretty unassuming. I read online that Hopewell was made possible by the County and Borough combining parcels of land to make one larger, more usable space. After that merger, volunteers amazingly did the rest.

As I look around, however, I can see there is more to this place than first meets the eye. Pine trees block the initial view, but as I pedal around them, I see a big dirt jump park and pump track that looks pretty new. In the middle of this area is a gazebo for viewing the activities, and off to the side is a handy bike workstation for making quick, basic repairs.

The jumps of the jump park are in various series of four jumps, each of different skill level. From mild to wild, there is something for everyone at this location. I see some guys on BMX bikes having a good time, as another person with a RC car is using the pump track as a course for his miniature truck.

I take my bike and head for the first loop trail, named "Down & Dirty". I chose this loop because it is listed as the easiest of three loops that make up the park. As I ride "Down & Dirty", I see that it was crafted using parts of an old rail trail, with sections wandering on and off the flat trail. A short, steep climb on a rocky spine makes me pay attention. It looks a little treacherous, but rides better than it looks. Then, after a quick section of field, which includes two fast turns, I'm back into the woods on the rail trail. From there, I make a couple of switchbacks between trees and ferns and then hop back on the trail for the final few hundred yards. Overall distance: a little more than a mile. "Easy" sounds fair, but it's definitely mountain biking, as opposed to touring or leisure bike riding. It's on to the next loop, called "Up and Out".

This loop trail is rated as "intermediate", so I'm expecting some challenge. The trail starts with a very short gully ride and gently climbs upward into a quiet section of forest with old growth trees. Like a roller coaster, at the top of the climb, it then drops to a short, wooden bridge, some bumps, and a second drop with some roots to maneuver. After that piece of



excitement comes another climb with winding switchbacks. At this point, I decide that I am going to ride the “Junk in the Trunk” trail to the upper park and the “harder stuff”. I haven’t hit anything I can’t handle yet, so why not?

“Junk in the Trunk” refers to the fact that the area actually used to be a dump. And I’m not saying that figuratively: it LITERALLY was a dump. As you travel on this trail you will start to encounter some of the “trail art” that has made this park a trendy destination. Pink elephants, gnomes, skulls, baby doll heads, Tonka toys, toilets, tires, skeletons, bottles, irons, plastic frogs, sneakers, rusty vintage cars and Coke machines are all things you will see along the trails.

As I’m riding, I hear voices of other riders. As their matching jerseys come into view, I realize this is the local NICA Interscholastic Mountain Biking team - the Hammers - rolling my way. They started in 2017 and are now part of the almost 40 team Pennsylvania League. The Hammers use Hopewell as their “home base” location and practice spot.

The team members all wanted to give me advice and tell me their favorite trails. As would be expected, some of the older kids seemed to favor the downhill and technical trails. I tried to remember all their advice as we parted ways. Next, I continued my journey on Junk in the Trunk towards the upper levels. As you climb, you will cross a bridge, made from a refrigerator door (appropriately named “Fridge-bridge”). At the top, you’ll find “Eight

Ball Trail”. This trail is a fun reward for your punishing climb.

The south side of the park is where I find all the elevation. Bullet Baby Trail is a local favorite, so I decide to take that one. I’m glad I did. What an adrenaline rush, of speed, turns, tabletop jumps and general trail artistry! After Bullet Baby, I’m getting tired and thinking about heading back. I’ve ridden only about 6 miles so far, but that’s enough for me. The Meadow Loop trail is a nice easy way to wind-down after all that elevation. I enjoy the butterflies, birds and grassy meadow views.

After the Meadow loop, I begin the final descent down to the parking lot. I’m cautious at first, but as things start rolling I see the trails are well made, and I gain confidence. Before long, I’m going at amazing speed, wheels and dirt flying, and I realize I’m giggling to myself.

Once I get back to the parking lot, I’m gassed, but smiling from ear to ear. In less than two hours, I had one heck of a ride! I was entertained and challenged at the same time, and I can’t wait to return. The turns and bumps make every ride memorable. Every town should be so lucky as to have a hidden gem like this in their back yard!
